What is Consensus?





Consensus is a decision-making process that not only seeks the agreement of most participants, but also to resolve or mitigate the objections of the minority to achieve the most agreeable decision.





What is a Standard?





A **standard** is an established norm or requirement. It is usually a formal document that establishes uniform engineering or technical criteria, methods, processes and practices.





The TNI Quality Systems Expert Committee is involved with the implementation process.

The LASC, NELAC BOD and Technical Committee will ask for implementation guidance documents.

The Quality Systems Expert Committee has been busy with a crosswalk document to the NELAC 2003 Checklist.

- Technical Modules Structure
 - Same structure in all technical modules
- Demonstration of Capability (DOC)
 - Technical Modules section 1.6
 - General Requirements
 - Initial DOC
 - Ongoing DOC
